

Embedding a Subscribe Button in CourseDen

1. Log into your podcast account by going to <http://podcasting.gcsu.edu>. Remember, if you need to create an account, contact Kevin Mobbs at kmobbs@westga.edu or call him at 678-839-5294.
2. Once you are logged into your account, click on Podcasting Channels in the left-hand side of the screen and then click on your Podcast Channel.



3. Under your Podcasting Episode List, click the Subscription Button at the very bottom of the table that says "Click here to get subscription button code for the GeorgiaVIEW VISTA."

4. When you click the link, a new window will appear with a code. Select the entire code by pressing Ctrl+A, right click on the text and scroll down to choose "Copy."

5. In CourseDen, go to the section where you wish to have your students subscribe to your podcast (Learning Modules, Discussion Board, Home Page, etc...).
6. Click on the action link next to Add File and select "Create File."



7. Type in a title for your podcast in the Title box. In the content box, paste the code that was copied in Step 4.

9. Under the "Teach" tab, open the Podcast where it was created, and click the button "Subscribe." Your podcast will be opened in iTunes.
