Step 1. Go to <http://uwgfdc.wikispaces.com/Workshop+Calendar> and find dates fitting your schedule

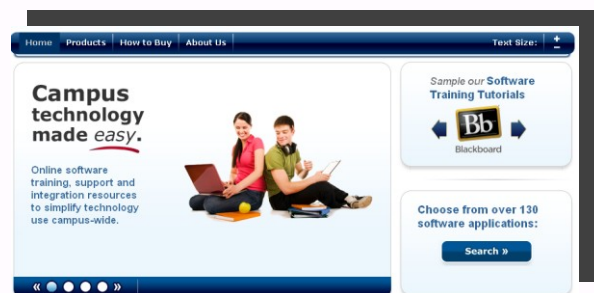
Step 2. Register for **ALL** dates you are able to attend. Click on the title of the event to register.
